## Job Responsibilities (all technical skills are taught during training school)

- Share knowledge of the area's natural history and ecology
- Participate in program prep and clean-up, inspect and maintain equipment, engage in staff meetings and debriefs
- Organize and support all program activities: ropes course, canoeing, team building, ecology and night hikes, campfires, gaga, rock gym, and more
